Covid-19 Safety Guidelines

MHSD

Please carefully read the information below which contains the details of how we will be running classes from September (given current guidelines)

1. Check temperature. Do not send your child if they have a sore throat, cough, sneeze or feel generally unwell. If children arrive displaying symptoms we will ask you to collect them and take them home.
2. Change into uniform for class at home and wear a warm coat.
3. Go to the toilet before leaving home (we must clean the toilets after each child which takes up class time).
4. Bring a full bottle of water, jazz or ballet shoes (no bare feet) and an exercise mat for Modern floor work.

WHEN YOU ARRIVE AT THE FRONT DOOR

1. Wait outside until the teacher calls your child in. Maintain social distancing. Parents must stay outside.
2. Each pupil will have their own chair for coat, water bottle, etc.
3. Come in one at a time, remove outdoor shoes BEFORE going into the hall and go straight to their chair.
4. The classes will have been divided into small groups of 4 to 6 pupils.
5. Pupils will be able to sanitize their hands during class when necessary.

ON LEAVING

1. Parents, please allow time for traffic problems and be on time for collection. We must clean the hall between classes, therefore we cannot allow anyone to remain in the building and will not be able to supervise your children if you are late.
2. Parents remain outside the front door and we will bring the children to you.

EXTRA REMINDER

Please understand that a pupil MUST NOT attend class if they or anyone else in the household has had Covid-19 symptoms in the last 10 days. If symptoms develop within 10 days of visiting the hall you must use the Test, Track and Trace system to alert others with whom they have been in contact - and of course, notify us.

FINALLY...

If anyone needs re-assurance as to the precautions that have been put in place at the halls, then please contact me. We have followed the government guidelines and those of Acre, RAD and ISTD. We feel it is safe for our pupils but are always open to suggestions and advice.
